## Effective Communications

The most basic leadership skill is communications. It seems simple and easy. Yet every organization has the need to improve their communications to their members and their customers. The reasons are shown by communications specialists.

The two words, information and communication are often used interchangeably, but they signify quite different things. Information is giving out; communication is getting through.

### Verbal versus Written Communications

The effectiveness of using different delivery techniques to remember information was determined by the 3M Corporation determined in a series of studies. They concluded that people remember:

- 10 percent of what they read
- 20 percent of what they hear
- 30 percent of what they see
- 60 percent of what they see, hear, and read

If we want our target audience to remember what we have communicated, we must use a combination of written and oral communication. Only using one or the other introduces a risk of our audience not remembering the message. Then, we must use a mixture of written and oral communication. Only using one or the other introduces risk of failure to communicate something clearly or correctly.
