

Quick update from the 8 December 2009 HELP ZIPPY meeting.

1. We have found that we cannot sell items at the Kitsap County Libraries so doing a vision screening in conjunction with coloring book sales is not going to work.

2. Feelings are best time to try and do coloring book sales would be around Easter or next fall at the craft sales in preparation for the holidays. R. Arper has action to contact coloring company to see about books geared to Easter. Noted that Roland and Evelynda are still playing "phone tag" to discuss best structure to sell the books.

3. Robert May reported that we have two areas that we could participate in the homeless count efforts in January. First is to do vision screening at their main site on 24 Jan. They have this main site with various services to entice homeless to come into the site and get those services and then get counted. Second would be to actually hit the streets and help do counting. Decision made to do the vision screening. Robert will get details on exact times and location and we will get a sign up sheet going around to the clubs. Planning meeting will be held on 11 Jan. Time and place to be determined. Associated with this is we need to discuss what do we do with those folks who we identify as needing exams/glasses. R. Arper will talk to LENSRAFTERS but we need to know if each club will be willing to support purchasing glasses and exams.

4. Still need to get representation from all the clubs. This is a zone project and we want to get all the clubs involved as much as possible...thanks...Roland
